CALL FOR PAPAERS

The 26th International Conference on Digital Signal Processing (DSP 2027), with the theme of **DSP for Interactive Intelligence**, technically co-sponsored by IEEE Signal Processing Society and EURASIP, will celebrate its 60th anniversary in June 2027 in the UK. It is the longest in existence Conference in the area of DSP and belongs to a series of events that commenced in London in 1967 and continued to Florence, Nicosia, Limassol, Santorini, Cardiff, Corfu, Hong-Kong, Singapore, Beijing, Shanghai, Rhodes, and Costa Navario in 2025. It will bring together leading experts from academia and industry to share the most recent and exciting advances in digital signal processing and celebrates its role in underpinning the modern AI.

DSP 2027 addresses the state-of-the-art techniques in signal processing, machine learning, and data-driven approaches and their diverse range of applications. Submitted papers will be reviewed by a minimum of two independent reviewers using a single-blind peer review process. Accepted papers will be submitted for inclusion into IEEE Xplore subject to meeting IEEE Xplore’s scope and quality requirements. The Conference social program will provide an opportunity to meet colleagues and friends.
